****Important Details! Please Read!****

Welcome to West Rocks Middle School and the Middle School Summer Transition Program. Students from Cranbury, Silvermine, and Tracey (or others coming to West Rocks) are invited to participate in our 5 week summer program, July 1 - August 1. **This program is generously funded through The Carver Foundation of Norwalk and Norwalk Public Schools, however there is a \$75 non-refundable fee upon registration.**

Research suggests that one of the most difficult transition points in education is from elementary to middle school. Navigating a larger environment, excelling with grades, having multiple teachers, and juggling competing priorities can be quite challenging. The West Rocks Summer Transition Program will be the necessary bridge into middle school.

Students enrolling in the program will participate in the following courses: English, Math, Science, Technology, and Study Skills. Students will take part in enrichment activities, including field trips, to enhance team building and the academic program. **Free Breakfast and lunch are provided each day for all students.**

ATTENDANCE AND PUNCTUALITY ARE EXPECTED EACH DAY as a great deal of material is covered in a short period of time. *Please don't apply if you know you'll be absent for an extended period of time.*

TRANSPORTATION will be provided to and from West Rocks for students who need to take the bus.

All Board of Education **CODE OF CONDUCT** policies are in effect during the summer program.

Students with other summer commitments should not register, including NPS Summer School. The program will not enroll students mandated to attend NPS Summer School.
