
### **Carver Loves Volunteers!**

#### **Our Work**

Carver Mission: To help children and youth reach their greatest potential by providing educational, social and recreational programs in a positive, safe and fun environment.

Carver is the largest provider of after school and summer programs for middle and high school students in Norwalk.

The Youth Development Program takes place at the Carver Community Center, Norwalk's four middle and two high schools, and at Side by Side Charter School.

CASPER, Carver's K-5 program, offers intensive project-based learning in science, literacy and math.

Summer Enrichment Programs include: 5-13-year-old students at the Carver Community Center and Columbus Magnet School; Freshman Summer Success Academies for graduated 8th-grade students transitioning into 9th grade at Norwalk and Brien McMahon High Schools; and Summer Middle School Transition Programs for 5th-grade students transitioning into two middle schools, aiming to serve all four Norwalk middle schools beginning in summer 2018.

Carver also provides college scholarships; parent leadership training; health and wellness programming; spring and fall college tours; food drives and community holiday events for the benefit of the Norwalk community.





## **Our Impact**

More than **800** students enrolled in Carver's after school and summer programs.

100% of Carver students advance to their next grades on time.

Since 2005, 100% of Carver seniors have graduated high school on time and nearly all become first generation college students.

**85%** of Carver college students graduate within six years from four-year colleges and universities.

Carver awards approximately **\$80,000** in college scholarships each year.

The new Charlotte Naomi Horblit Technology Center located at the Carver Community Center includes 24 PCs, eight iMac computers with Retina 5K displays, a 3-D printer, and a large touch-screen smart-board at the front of the room.

Carver is the only community-based Norwalk charity to receive the highest awards for financial stewardship and transparency from the nation's two premiere rating agencies, Charity Navigator and Guidestar.





# **Our Educational Programs**

Carver is the largest provider of after school and summer programs in Norwalk. More than 800 Carver youth experience a wide variety of personalized educational programs that are challenging, relevant, and rigorous. Carver Program Coordinators are certified teachers from the students' respective schools. In addition, volunteer professionals and other nonprofit organizations provide enrichment opportunities such as robotics and preengineering. Carver provides free transportation.
